### Pediculosis

As the weather and temperatures continue to fluctuate, and students are wearing coats, hats and mitts we feel that it is important to remind parents/guardians to check your child(ren) regularly (2 to 3 times per week) for head lice and nits. Catching them early is the key to limiting the spread within your household and at school. If head lice are found on a student at school, a letter is sent home with students in that class to alert parents/guardians that the condition is present. Students with nits (eggs) and/or live head lice must be treated with a head lice shampoo. We remind parents/guardians to please notify the office if their child(ren) has/have nits and/or lice so that we can try and limit and prevent the spread.

## Winter Safety

This is just a reminder that students are not allowed to go off the tarmac if they do not have boots and snow pants. The playground equipment continues to remain closed for the winter. As a result, children are not to play on the equipment.

Children should be reminded regularly about snow safety, for example:

- skin exposure
- throwing snow
- walking near the roadway
- tunneling under a pile of snow
- walking/playing on icy patches
- playing on snow hills that form
