Safe and Caring Learning Environment

To ensure the safety of everyone in our building, we need to remind parents/guardians that the doors are locked during the school day. Should you wish to pick up your child prior to dismissal, please ring the outside door buzzer and we will gladly escort your child to you. If students arrive late to school, they must go directly to the office for a late slip so that we can ensure a safe arrival. Our school hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. Please note that there is no supervision prior to 8:15 a.m.; students should not be arriving at the school prior to 8:15 a.m. Thank you for ensuring your child arrives on time and remains until dismissal.

Valentine's Day

During Valentine's Day celebrations, you may choose to bring non-food items such as cards, pencils, stickers etc. However, when considering food items, please ensure the food is nut free, and the nut free label is clearly visible and that the food item is individually wrapped.

Hot Lunch Reminder

Plan of Care

Schools are responsible for planning to support students who have serious medical concerns such as anaphylaxis, asthma, diabetes, and other health issues that may be life threatening. If your child has serious medical concerns, please contact the school to further discuss the details. Please do not send products containing nuts with your child to school.

Clothing and Footwear

As we continue to experience colder weather, all families are reminded to ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the colder weather. Coats, jackets, hats, gloves and suitable footwear are needed when we go outdoors. Also, please make certain your child has the appropriate indoor footwear. Footwear, free of dirt and debris, must always be worn in the building for health and safety reasons.



Lost and Found Items

Student Cell Phones

The staff at Rosedale Public School recognizes that personal electronic devices such as cell phones are part of our culture. If fog causes a cancellation in the morning, there will still be transportation at the end of the day.
