ONLINE LEARNING

Last month, Mrs. Gadhia and Mrs. Tessier made chocolate chip cookies with their FDK class. Baking is a wonderful and delicious way to spend time together, offline, while still learning! Here is Mrs. Gadhia's recipe:

Ingredients

3/4 c soft butter
3/4 c brown sugar
1/4 c white sugar
1 egg
2 tsp vanilla
2 c flour
2 tsp cornstarch
1 tsp baking soda
1 c chocolate chips

Beat the first three ingredients together with electric mixer until smooth. Mix in the egg and vanilla and continue beating until soft. Sift the remaining dry ingredients together and then add to wet dough and beat until mixed. Stir in the chocolate chips. Bake at 350 degrees for 8-10 mins. Make dough into balls and put on a greased cookie sheet :)

So where is the learning?

You can point out: shapes (cookies are circles, a box of corn starch is a rectangular prism); count the number of cookies in a batch, the number of ingredients needed for a recipe. Measuring the ingredients and talk about fractions (is $1/2$ greater or lesser than $1/3$?) and how to double or halve a recipe. Show kids how to tell time so the cookies aren't overbaked! Math isn't the only thing kids will learn when baking and cooking. There are opportunities for reading as well! It's important to read the recipe before starting cooking, and there are nuances to recipes that mean different things, which is an important thing to learn.

- Proof of residency (e.g., utility or tax bill, lease/rental agreement, etc.)

NATIONAL INDIGENOUS HISTORY MONTH

On May 31, the Lambton Kent District School Board lowered its flags to half-mast to honour the lives of the 215 children whose remains were found at the Kamloops Indian Residential School. We recognize that the tragic news of the discovery of the bodies of 215 children at the site of a former residential school has a significant and lasting impact on survivors of residential schools, Indigenous students, staff, families, and the broader community. We acknowledge the ongoing intergenerational trauma and harm caused by the residential school system and settler colonialism. On Thursday, June 3, LKDSB invites students and staff to participate in an Orange Shirt Day. Students and staff are encouraged to wear orange to honour the survivors of residential schools, as well as those children and young people who never returned home. June is National Indigenous History Month and a time for all Canadians to reflect upon and learn the history, sacrifices, cultures, contributions, and strength of First Nations, Inuit, and Métis people. LKDSB will be recognizing June 21 as National Indigenous Peoples Day. On this day and throughout the year, we honour the history, heritage, and diversity of Indigenous peoples in Canada. The LKDSB believes student success is achieved through the shared responsibility of students, staff, families, community, and Indigenous partners.
