A Friendly Reminder.....

When carrying a personal electronic device, it is the student's responsibility if lost, stolen or damaged.

Medication

Medication: If your child needs prescription medication administered during school hours, please contact the office for an "Authorization for the Administration of Oral Medication" form. It must be completed by the parent/guardian and signed by a pharmacist or physician and forwarded to the principal every school year. Updates to the school are required whenever the physician directs a modification of the prescribed medication. We cannot administer any medications without this completed form. If your child is required to have medication at school (EPI-Pen, inhaler), please contact the office so we can ensure that their Individual Medical Plan is up to date and accurate.

Allergy Alert!

Please be aware that some students and staff have an allergy to nuts and to shellfish which includes shrimp, peanuts, peanut butter, peanut oils, peanut bi-products, sesame seeds, and other tree nuts. Exposure to these kinds of nut products – even trace amounts - could result in a life-threatening reaction.
