Treaties Recognition Week

During the week of November 7th, the Lambton Kent District School Board commemorates Treaties Recognition Week. Throughout the week, schools will be working towards greater understanding of treaties, treaty relationships, and the responsibilities we have to raise awareness about Indigenous histories, cultures, contributions, and perspectives. We have a diverse population of Indigenous students, leaders, and staff in the LKDSB who enrich our classrooms and workplaces every day. Treaties Recognition Week is an opportunity to reaffirm the importance of learning about and understanding Indigenous perspectives. Tecumseh Public School is proud to take part in this important learning. Chatham-Kent is located in the area that is part of Treaty 2, or the McKee Purchase. This Treaty was signed on May 19, 1790 by representatives of the Crown and various First Nations. It is the southernmost Upper Canada treaty. There were over 50 signatories to this Treaty, including settlers and Indigenous leaders. Current communities in the area also include Windsor, Chatham-Kent and part of London. A federal historic plaque commemorating this treaty is located in Blenheim Memorial Park.

Colder Weather is Coming

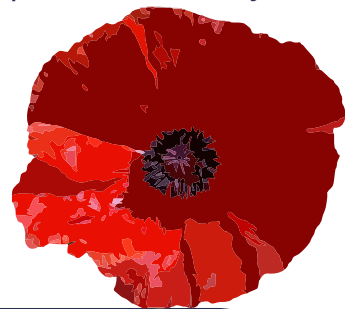
