<u>April</u>

Welcome spring!! We've been working hard in Grade 2 and have been anxiously waiting for warmer spring temperatures.

<u>Reading</u>: As a class, we have been reading a variety of fairy tale stories to model what a good narrative sounds like for our writing. We continue to make retelling books during and after reading a focus as well.

<u>Writing</u>: We have been working on writing narratives which are stories that involve a character who has a problem that must be solved. The character attempts multiple times to try to solve the problem before reaching a final solution at the end. It has been very interesting to read these narratives!

<u>Math</u>: We have begun our unit on 'Patterning and Algebra' in which the students will have to find numerous ways to make a given number (i.e. 13+5=18, 16+2=18, 10+8=18), find a missing number in a variety of equations (i.e. 13+___=16), and complete fact families (i.e. 5+4=9, 4+5=9, 9-5=4, 9-4=5).

<u>Homework</u>: Please make sure your child reads the 3 books sent home each Monday. They need to record the books they have read in the duotang and choose 1 book to write about in the workbook. These books are part of our classroom library and it is very important that they be <u>returned every Friday</u>. Also, please make sure your child returns Word Work Homework <u>each Monday</u>.
