Winter Dress

With the ever-changing weather, please ensure that your children are dressed appropriately with hats, boots, waterproof mittens/gloves (waterproof are best) and warm coats. This is also a great time of year to wear layers so that children can adjust their clothing as the temperature warms throughout the day.

Our students enjoy playing outside twice a day for twenty minutes each break and we want all of them to feel comfortable. There may also be times when a teacher wants to have the students do some outdoor learning and students need to be dressed appropriately for the weather.



Head Lice

As we get into the colder months of the year, and there is the possibility of students sharing toques, etc., all students should be reminded of steps they can take to reduce the likelihood of getting head lice. Even though lice do not jump or fly, they can spread from one student to another by sharing combs, brushes, clothing and hats (things that should be avoided anyway with current limitations in place). Anyone can get head lice; all members of the household need to be checked when there is one case of head lice in your immediate family, or the cycle of treatment and infestation can be continuous.

We would like to show our appreciation to all parents who arrive at the school before students are released at the end of the day. Your efforts at dismissal are essential towards ensuring that the building is cleared at the end of the day so staff can go home to their families as well. Safe Commuting

Vehicles have less traction, so students need to be very aware of traffic, as they walk to and from school. Technology (School Devices and Personal Phones)

Students and parents should review the <u>Responsible Use of Technology</u> guidelines to ensure that students are aware of their responsibilities when using the school internet and devices at Victor Lauriston.

All electronic devices, such as cell phones, media players, digital games devices, computers and cameras are not to be used while the student is on school property before, during, or after school without the permission of school staff and is only to be used for educational purposes. Personal electronic devices are to be kept in backpacks while at school unless the student has permission from the teacher of educational use. When carrying a personal electronic device, it is the student's responsibility if lost, stolen or damaged. At no time will students use electronic devices for digital, audio or video recording without permission from the teacher. When students need to contact home/parent, it is important that they notify the school staff rather than use an electronic option to ensure staff are aware. During nutrition breaks students are not to be using electronic devices; they are to be stored in backpacks. The focus is always surrounded around responsible use of technology, and to encourage student physical activity and socialization opportunities during nutrition breaks.

Inclement Weather

In cases of severe weather, listen to CFCO (AM 630 and FM 92.9), CKSY (FM 94.3) and Cool FM (FM 95.1) beginning at 6:30 a.m. Information is also posted at School Bus Info. Follow the School Bus and Weather Info link on the LKDSB website. Our School is located in ZONE 8.

Student Transportation Services also offers the **MySBI** mobile app to receive instant notifications of school bus delays, and cancellations.
