

Student Timetables

Courses were chosen by a guidance counsellor for each student based on the courses in the student's original timetable and on meeting diploma requirements. The master course timetable was built to accommodate the greatest number of students and their student course requests. As a result, students will not necessarily have the same courses as the ones they selected in the spring. Since most courses in the areas of The Arts, Health and Physical Education, and Technology are not being offered in the Virtual Learn at Home Secondary School, these courses have been substituted with other elective courses.

The teachers of the first quadmester courses will send an email to students to their LKDSB Google email account (i.e. firstname.lastname@lkdsb.com) by Friday, September 11. The email will introduce the teacher as well as give instructions on how to access the course.

Each school day is the equivalent of four consecutive classes in the regular semester system. As well, classes are close to full. As a result, students will not be permitted to change their first quadmester classes unless they are missing the course pre-requisite (e.g. taking grade eleven math without having successfully completed grade ten math) or the student has already successfully completed the course.

Students will be able to have their courses in quadmesters two through four reviewed with a guidance counsellor. Timetable revisions may be made where it aligns better with student interests and post-secondary plans and where there is room in courses.
