# **Keep WJB Up To Date!**

Students will be bringing registration verification packages home. Please ensure that all contact and student information is correct, make any changes necessary and return it to the school with your child(ren). Should your information change during the school year, please update the school office.

#### Scooters, Skateboards & Bikes

Students are welcome to ride scooters, skateboards and bikes to WJ Baird, however they must not be ridden on school property, and they will need to be secured in the bike racks. We have far too many of these to allow them to be stored in the school as it causes tripping hazards, and we lack adequate storage space for them. Students are encouraged to secure their item with a lock and families are reminded as with any item brought from home, the school will not be responsible for loss, theft or damage.

#### **Arrival & Dismissal**

Our school day begins with an entrance bell at 9:10 am. Any student who arrives after 9:10 am will be considered late, and will report directly to the front office, where their arrival will be recorded before they go to class. Being present and punctual each day is critical in a successful school year and for academic success.

Morning supervision begins at 8:55am. **Students cannot arrive at WJB prior to 8:55am when supervision is available**. If your child needs to be picked up from school prior to the dismissal bell, please call the office and our staff will arrange for your child to meet you at the office. We ask that all parents communicate directly with the office for such matters rather than communicating directly with your child via electronic device. This allows our office staff to manage student attendance and safety for students. Please note that any change in a student's normal routine such as not getting on their bus at the end of the day needs to be communicated directly by parents to the school, otherwise the usual daily routine will be followed.

#### **BYOD & Cell Phone Use**

Mobile technology has become a part of daily life. The LKDSB has invested in a BYOD Wi-Fi network that will allow students to Bring Their Own Device and login to use the internet much like they would on a school computer. We welcome students to bring their own mobile devices to support their learning. The BYOD users are subject to the same expectations as when using LKDSB technology, and the Acceptable Use of Technology Policy always applies. The use of technology will be at the discretion of the teacher, and there will be times that students will not access devices. Please be aware that the LKDSB and WJB will not assume responsibility for any device that is lost, stolen, or damaged when brought to school. Devices will only be used with the permission of and under the supervision of a staff member. Students who are permitted to bring a cell phone to school must submit the WJB Cell Phone at School Agreement and comply with the expectations outlined in it.

The use of personal devices and cell phones will be to the discretion of the teacher, and students will be able to access these devices only with permission from the supervising teacher. Should you need to contact your child during instructional time, please contact the office.

### **Orange Shirt Day**

#### National Day for Truth and Reconciliation - Orange Shirt Day - September 30th

The Government of Canada has formally designated September 30th, National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, as a statutory holiday for employees in the federal government and federally regulated workplaces. This day will be observed to honour First Nations, Inuit and Metis survivors and their families and communities, and ensure the public commemoration of their history and the legacy of residential schools.

The Lambton Kent District School Board will commemorate the impact of residential schools on Friday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 – Orange Shirt Day. Students and staff are encouraged to wear orange shirts and use this day as a catalyst to encourage learning and understanding about the residential school system and the impacts that system has had on First Nations, Metis, and Inuit people. This is a meaningful way for school communities to come together in a spirit of reconciliation and hope because "Every Child Matters". Respectfully, flags at all LKDSB schools and facilities will be lowered on this day.

This recognition day will be part of the activities and discussions occurring during the Truth and Reconciliation Week September 25<sup>th</sup> to September 29<sup>th</sup> which will also include discussions about the truth of Indigenous treaties, languages and culture and First Nation, Metis, and Inuit land claims.



In honouring and remembering those impacted by residential schools, LKDSB had commissioned a new orange shirt design in 2021. Orange shirts are available for order by interested staff and students from Screenart, a company in Wallaceburg. Screenart has created an online store for LKDSB orders, therefore staff and families will submit payment online directly to Screenart.

### **School Bus Infor-New App**

CLASS uses the SchoolBusInfo - Bus Status 4 app to push notifications to subscribers for inclement weather cancellations and school bus delays. This is a new app that differs from the one used in past years. The MySBI Bus Status app is available for iPhone and Android.

REMINDER: As school bus routes change every year; you will need to re-select your symbols for the new school year after August 1st.
