Item	Discussion	Action/Responsibility
Welcome and Introductions	Gayle Stucke welcomed the committee and thanked everyone for participating.	
	Gayle stated that the goal of the Transition Committee is to help provide students with a safe and smooth transition and to ensure the best possible transition for students, staff, parents, and members of the community. This is a very important job for the committee members.	
	Introductions were made around the table.	

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Review of Agenda	Gayle Stucke reviewed the agenda.	
Purpose of Transition Committee	Gayle Stucke reviewed the School Closure Implementation Administrative Procedure.	
Timelines	The November meeting will include information and discussion about the Ministry decision on Capital projects for changes to the current Wyoming campus.  All transition items are anticipated to be in place by September 2017. The Transition Committee will conclude prior to the opening of the consolidated school, but a follow up meeting could be scheduled following the transition if the committee chooses to do so.	
Sub-committees	Gayle Stucke stated that a major part of each transition meeting will be a report from the sub-committees. The role of the sub-committee is to discuss and bring recommendations to the Transition Committee, who will make the final decision. 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	A future sub-committee called School Spirit will be established in Spring 2017. This sub-committee will have the responsibilities of deciding on school colours and mascot once the school has been named.	
	The committee decided that a Student Orientation Sub-committee is not necessary as the current School Improvement Team is responsible for organizing activities to bring the two schools together and help with the transition. The School Improvement Team will provide an update on student orientation at future Transition Meetings. There will also be a report on communication at the Transition Meetings.	
	Gayle suggested that the committee members could contact a member of a past transition committee to help with ideas on what should be done to aid in the transition process for South Plympton/Wyoming Public School. Principal Andy Parnham will put any members wishing to do this in contact with a school council chair from a school that has undergone an Accommodation Review.	
Questions/Suggestions from the Public	<ul> <li>No members of the public were in attendance at the meeting.</li> <li>Questions/Suggestions from the members:</li> <li>Any media communication will go through Principal Andy Parnham.</li> <li>The annual Play Day, organized by Wyoming Public School students for the South Plympton Public School students, will continue.</li> <li>Funds for special events will come from school funds.</li> <li>The board will co-ordinate a moving date and help organize the move from South Plympton Public School to Wyoming Public School. Gayle Stucke stated that the classrooms should remain welcoming and attractive for students as late as possible prior to the move in order to ensure a smooth transition for the students.</li> <li>There will be a future discussion on outdoor space.</li> <li>The Architects responsible for the design of the school will be invited to a future Transition Meeting so the committee members can ask questions</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>about the design.</li> <li>There will be future presentations from Best Start and the Transportation department.</li> <li>Additional sub-committees could be formed during the process.</li> </ul>	

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	A member could join a sub-committee at a later date.  The committee decided that it would be beneficial to add another student representative to the committee. Teaching representative Brandon Owen will provide a name suggestion to Principal Andy Parnham for approval.  Gary Girardi was asked about a September transition of students to the Wyoming Public School site and responded that the date of the Ministry announcement on funding has been pushed back so the timeline is dependent on when the announcement is made.	
Next Meeting Date	There was considerable discussion about the night of the week that worked best for most members and tentative dates were selected. Since that time, the November 21, 2016 date has been changed to November 28, 2016. The committee agreed on a 6:30 p.m. start time with adjournment no later than 8:30 p.m.  The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, November 28, 2016 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at Wyoming Public School.
