

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

SUBJECT: Organization of the Elementary School Day

PREAMBLE

- 1. Principals are responsible for the effective organization of the school day. This Procedure refers to two types of organization the traditional school day and the balanced school day.
- 2. The traditional school day provides a lunch period of at least 40 minutes and shorter recess breaks in the morning and the afternoon.
- 3. The balanced school day provides two breaks of at least 40 minutes one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The principal will engage in a full consultation process with staff, School Council, school community and affected partners regarding a proposed change to the organization of the school day.
- 2. The recommendation to change the organization of the school day will be made by the Principal with approval by the Director of Education.
- 3. The organization of the school day will not compromise the amount of instructional time required by law and will comply with employee contracts.
- 4. A change in the organization of the school day is not likely to be approved if it creates additional costs to the Board.
- 5. The principal will provide notification of the change in organization of the elementary school day well in advance of the change.
- 6. The organization of the school day will be reviewed annually.
