The Provincial Code of Conduct and School Board Codes of Conduct - PPM 128

The provincial Code of Conduct has been revised to include a restriction on the use of personal mobile devices during instructional time.

The revised LKDSB Code of Conduct and it states the following:

Students are to be treated with respect and dignity. In return, they must demonstrate respect for themselves, for others, and for the responsibilities of citizenship through acceptable behaviour. Respect and responsibility are demonstrated when a student:

- comes to school prepared, on time, and ready to learn;
- shows respect for himself or herself, for others, and for those in authority;
- refrains from bringing anything to school that may compromise the safety of others;
- follows the established rules and takes responsibility for his or her own actions;
- works in an environment that is conducive to learning and teaching, including by ensuring that personal mobile devices are only used during instructional time for the educational and permitted purposes in the following circumstances
 - for educational purposes as directed by an educator
 - for health or medical purposes
 - to support special education needs
- cell phones, cameras and other digital imaging and/or audio recording devices are NOT permitted to be used in change rooms or washrooms at any time.

All CKSS students should now be aware the use of cell phones is prohibited in class during instructional time unless the teacher deems the mobile device has an educational purpose during that class.
