RETURNING TO SCHOOL FOLLOWING THE BREAK - COVID SCREENING

In preparation for the winter break, the LKDSB encourages families to remain vigilant and follow the health and safety protocols in place to mitigate the transmission of COVID-19, including completing and following the directions of the [daily school screening assessment](#) tool upon the return to school.

For those individuals traveling outside of Canada, as per the federal travel guidelines and the directions of the [Ontario COVID-19 school and child care screening](#), unvaccinated children under the age of 12 who travel outside of Canada with a fully vaccinated companion are exempt from federal quarantine; however, **they are not permitted to attend a school or child care for 14 days following their return.**

Throughout the school year and particularly during the COVID-19 pandemic, the LKDSB follows legislated health and safety and public health protocols. We consistently follow the direction of the local and provincial medical officers of health and the Ministry of Education regarding COVID-19 and communicate information as per their direction.
