Our students have worked with students to determine engaging alternative recess ideas to help keep students engaged and having fun at recess! Our Badgers are looking forward to these options!

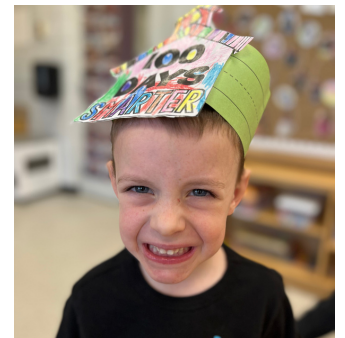
BIG BOX CARDS - \$35 A BOX

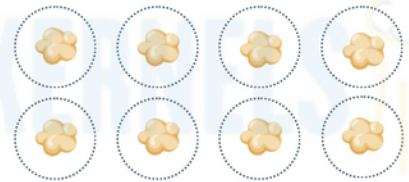
