

School Council Elections

The group that makes up the Council are members of our parent/guardian community as well as teacher representative and principal. Our School Council can formally be made up of up to 14 members. The group that makes up our formal Council is to be nominated and then elected (only in the event that there are more than 14 nominees). This has historically not been the case at King George as our numbers are below the 14 threshold. These formal members are then responsible for attending regular meetings as well as nominating and voting for the executive (Chair, Secretary and Treasurer).

In accordance with these regulations you will find on the reverse a nomination form that you can complete should you be interested in joining our School Council. Please return these forms no later than Tuesday, October 4, 2016 to the school. Elections or members to be acclaimed will be held on the Tuesday, October 18th meeting to be held at the school beginning at 6:00.

Prior to this meeting, I will share if we will be having a formal election or the School Council Membership will be acclaimed.
