We are making these dates available to all students registered in Grade 12 at LCCVI to help make sure that you are aware of some of the important events, meetings, and deadlines that will occur throughout the school year. Students and their parents are encouraged to attend the virtual college, university, and OSAP application presentations that most colleges and universities are holding weekly, if not daily. Students are advised to check into the 2021 Potential Grads Google Classroom regularly for updated information about post-secondary opportunities and scholarship/bursary information. ## October 2020

- Classroom Post-Secondary Planning Sessions for all Gr. 12 classrooms.
- Student Information submitted to OCAS/OUAC
- October 28: full disclosure date for Quad 1 classes. Classes dropped prior to this date don't show up on transcripts; those dropped after this date will show mark at time of withdrawal as well as a "withdrawn" notation. This can negatively affect the application process.

## November 2020

- Online OCAS and OUAC applications begin. OUAC PINs to be given out to all university-eligible students.
- Week of November 16: Quad 1 final marks issued.

## December 2020

- December 1: deadline for college-bound students to have their OCAS application finished with at least one Lambton College program selected; Lambton College will generously cover the \$95 application fee.

- December 2: Full-disclosure date for Sem.1 classes.
- Students are encouraged to complete their College and/or University applications **BEFORE** the end of December. Counsellors are available to assist.

### **January 2021**

- January 12: deadline to notify school of intent to transfer between Face-to-Face/Learn-at-Home for Quad 3.
- January 13: Full-disclosure date for Quad 2 classes.
- January 15: University applications due (for equal consideration).

### **February 2021**

- February 1: College applications due (for equal consideration). This is also the earliest date the Colleges may release offers to applicants. Offers will continue to be issued until programs are filled or waitlists are established.
- Late February: LCCVI course selection for returning students (2021/2022).
- Late February: Nicol Scholarship Information Virtual Meeting.

### **March 2021**

- March 13 – 21: Students should plan to visit some of the many College and University open houses if available this week! (March Break is March 15<sup>th</sup> – March 19<sup>th</sup>.)
- March 30: deadline to notify school of intent to transfer between Face-to-Face/Learn-at-Home for Quad 4.
- March 31: full disclosure for Quad 3 courses.

### **April 2021**

- Midterm marks reported to the Colleges and Universities.
- Early April: Cap & Gown Order forms due to Student Services.
- 
- April 30: Nicol Scholarship applications due to Student Services by 2:20 pm.

## **May 2021**

- May 1: Most common deadline for OCAS (College) applicants to confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to their chosen program ([www.ontariocolleges.ca](http://www.ontariocolleges.ca)).
- OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program) presentation to outline procedures and guidelines (**date and time to be determined**).
- May 11: Full disclosure date for Sem 2 courses
- May 28: Community Involvement Hours due for students planning to graduate this year!
- May 27: The latest date by which all Secondary School Applicants shall expect a response from an Ontario University.

## **June 2020**

- June 1: The earliest date by which Ontario Universities may require a response to an offer of admission and a financial commitment of any kind (i.e. registration deposit, residence deposit etc.)
- Monday, June 1: Earliest date that Colleges may require payment of tuition fees.
- June 2: Full disclosure date for Quad 4 courses
- June 10: Tentative Date for Class of 2019/2020 Celebration.
- June 15: Board/School Awards/Scholarships/Bursary applications due in Student Services.
- June 18: Final Evaluation days begin.
