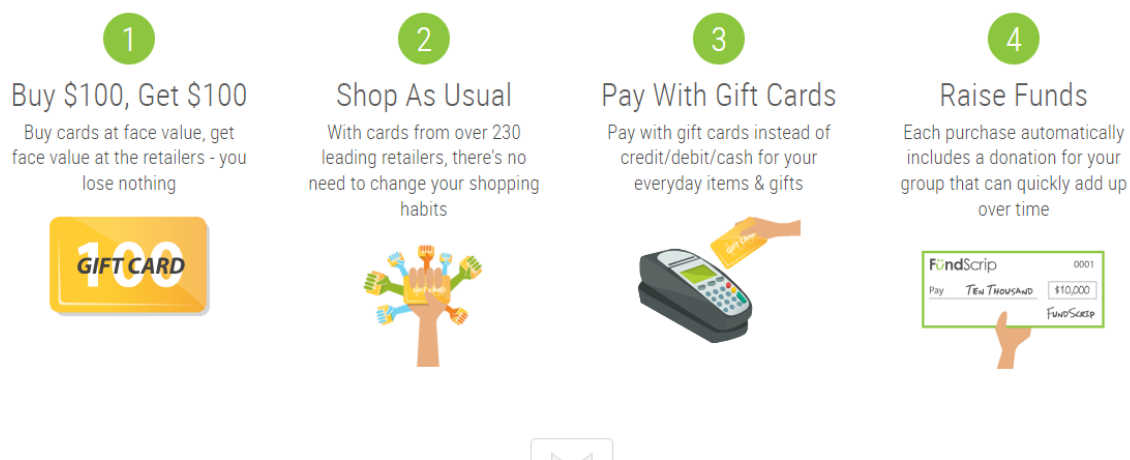


FundScrip Fundraiser

FundScrip began in Montreal, Quebec in 2004 as a unique program targeting parents who wanted to save money for their children's education. Using virtually the same model we use today; parents would buy gift cards to pay for their everyday purchases to raise cash donations towards their children's RESP's. The program has since evolved to become a general fundraiser for groups as diverse as schools, churches & other faith-based organizations, sports teams & clubs, charitable foundations, community & service groups, etc.
