## Skating Program Launch

We are very excited to be partnering with former Falcon and current Florida Panther, Brandon Montour, in starting up a skating program for our students. The long-term goal is to be able to bring the entire school to the Tilbury Arena throughout the year to participate in ice skating as a part of their Phys Ed program. Brandon has generously provided funding to purchase helmets and we are extremely grateful for his support.

We are asking for families to consider donating their gently used skates to the school for shared use by our students - currently we are looking for skates that will fit Grade 2-6 students. We are aware that many families do not have skates and in order to be able to offer this program to everyone in a barrier-free manner, the school will provide all students in need with a pair of skates and/or helmet to wear.

As an added incentive, Brandon has provided us with a signed Florida Panthers hat to be raffled off. In addition, we also have a signed Windsor Spitfire stick as a second raffle prize. For every pair of skates donated, families will receive a ballot for these great prizes! The draw will be held at the May Awesome Awards Assembly!

## Kindergarten Yard

The Kindergarten team have joined up with the Lower Thames Valley Conservation Authority to create a mud kitchen and a pollinator garden. Students will be able to play in the mud kitchen, exploring and mucking about as they learn about the textures of our world. As well, they have been doing some learning about pollinators and their importance to our planet.
In order to preserve the garden, we have made the decision to chain the fence during non-school hours. We ask for you cooperation that if coming to play at the school after hours, that you make use of our play equipment and field and leave the Kindergarten area alone, so that the garden can take hold.

## Smile Cookie Campaign

Hot lunches continue to be a great success and a time saver for many families. As we move forward through the year, the plan is to offer the following:

- Pizza (Fridays)- orders sent out for 2-3 months at a time - all orders are finished for the year
- Harvest Fresh (Tuesdays) - also sent out 2 months at a time - all orders are finished for the year
- Subway - each month we'll offer an opportunity to purchase sandwiches from Subway

Money raised through hot lunch sales goes into the Student Trust Fund, which is used to subsidize field trips, contribute to Grade 8 Graduation and purchase equipment for student use.

## Awesome Awards Assembly

We are continuing our monthly celebration of all the things that are awesome about being a TAPS Falcon. Teachers will be able to nominate students for an Awesome Award when they have been observed doing something Awesome within the school/playground. We'll honour these students at the assembly and families will be notified in advance so they may come and celebrate with us. ## School Registration

## Drop Off and Pick Up

Students should not be dropped off before 9:00 in the morning, as the yard is unsupervised until that time. As well, please encourage your children to head straight home after school instead of playing at the school or park.
If you need to pick your child up early, please let the office know. Our attendance phone line is active 24 hours a day and you are welcome to leave a message on it at any time. We ask that parents avoid picking up their children between 3:15-3:35 as the school is very busy at that time and to ensure the safety of every student, we need to be able to account for everyone.

## Playground Equipment

Our playground equipment has been inspected and has been reopened for use. If using the equipment after hours, we ask that you do so safely and with caution.
The GaGa Ball pit has not yet been reopened as we await a shipment of chip filler. Once this has arrived, we'll be able to reopen it as well. We would ask that everyone refrains from using the GaGa Ball area outside of school hours as it is not deemed safe for operation.

## Bus Cancellations - Zone 7

During the spring we might experience some heavy fog in which there could be the potential for bus cancellations. During the spring season, when there are bus cancellations due to fog, buses will not run in the morning but will run in the afternoon to bring students home.
